Dear Parents/Carers,

I am currently looking into arranging an Early Years Christmas visit for all the children within Early Years, both Nursery and Reception, to Whitehouse Farm in December and would appreciate your thoughts.

At the farm the children would receive a bag of animal food, have the opportunity to hold the animals and learn about where they live and what they eat as well as have the opportunity to write a letter to Father Christmas, meet him in person and receive a small gift. What a great day!

We would leave school around 9.30am and return for the end of the school day at 3.15pm. Your child would need a packed lunch for the trip.

We would need approximately 18 accompanying adults to join us, which would be on a first come basis and would join us on the coach. However, other adults would be welcome to join us at the farm, making their own way and paying their own entry in.

The PTFA are kindly able to support this visit by making a contribution of £500. This would make the cost of the visit £7.50 per person which includes entry into Whitehouse Farm for one child and the transportation by coach there and back. The amount would be able to be made in stages from October to December. As a school we are only able to ask for voluntary contributions however if we are unable to cover the cost then I am sure you understand that such a visit would not be feasible.

If your child is eligible to free school meals because you are in receipt of benefits, or your child is a pupil premium, there will be no charge for the trip.

Please could you indicate on the slip below whether you would like the trip to go ahead or not and return to school by Tuesday 29th September.
