Dear Parents/Carers

In Early Years we have the fantastic opportunity to visit Jesmond Dene as our school trip this summer.

Jesmond Dene is one of Newcastle's Ouseburn Parks and is a popular location for Nursery and Reception aged children. Our visit will include; a workshop run by the Jesmond Dene Educational Team linking to familiar stories, opportunity to explore Jesmond Dene, having lunch and visiting Pet's corner.

Due to the number of children in Early Years we will split into two groups consisting of both Nursery and Reception children and we would love as many parents/carers as possible to come and join us. Parent/Carer volunteers will be subject to a List 99 security check if looking after other children on the trip. (please enquire at the office) Unfortunately we will not be able to allow younger siblings to join us.

We are hoping to go on Thursday 27th June for Morning Nursery and Class 1 and Friday 28th June for Afternoon Nursery and Class 2. We will travel by bus leaving school at approximately 9.45 and returning for 2.30pm. On the day your child does not attend the trip school will be operate as normal for Reception aged children, but be closed to Nursery.

The cost of the trip will be £5.00 per child, this contributes to the workshop session at Jesmond Dene and transport there and back. Children will need a packed lunch on the day of their visit, no glass bottles.
