

## Literacy

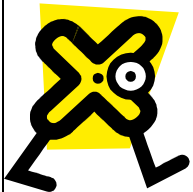
After some great story writing this term's literacy work will move onto non fiction texts and writing. We will read and write instructions and explanations. We will write instructions for making a musical instrument and explain how we hear to link our literacy work to our topic work.

WOW words are essential for helping to make our writing interesting! We will continue to focus on exchanging simple word choices for more adventurous language.

As always we will continue to develop phonological awareness through regular phonic sessions. The children will be encouraged to read and write high frequency words which will aid their independent reading and writing.



## Numeracy



Sorting data and finding answers to questions using this will be our starting point this half term along with exploring the units of measure for length, weight and capacity (mm, cm, m, kg and l). Can they use a ruler to measure accurately? Do they know what weighs less than, about the same as or more than a kg? If a jug holds 4 litres of water, how many litres do 6 jugs hold? The children will learn to add and subtract using an empty numberline (we will send a leaflet home to demonstrate how we do this at school). They will also find out how to calculate missing numbers which appear anywhere in a number sentence. We will use our knowledge of counting in twos, fives and tens to answer multiplication and division questions.
