

Literacy

This half term we will start by looking at the story Eco Zico, a tale about a boy who discovers that he has a very useful super power. The children will write letters, design characters and complete sculpture work for our book week display.

Year 2 will also be looking at stories by the same author (Anthony Browne) including the popular stories of The Tunnel and Gorilla. We will use our inference skills to decide what might happen and make plausible predictions. We will use the stories to explore characters and look for similarities and differences across his texts, linking them to other books we have read.

Phonics will continue to be taught daily and we will build upon the work covered during the Autumn term. The children will also continue their weekly guided reading and comprehension sessions.

Numeracy

Number work involves solving problems using our calculation skills. We will look at addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. For their work on multiplication and division it is vital that the children are able to count on and back in steps of 2, 3, 5, 10. The children will also measure the length and height of everyday objects

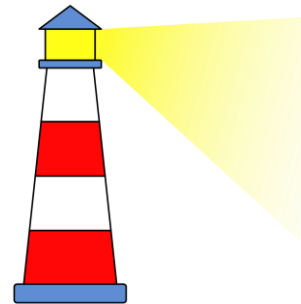
The children will continue to work on fractions of $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{3}{4}$ and $\frac{1}{3}$ looking at fractions of number, shapes and amounts. The children will learn to read clocks to the nearest five minutes. We will also continue to encourage the development of fluency and reasoning skills as well as providing the opportunity to solve a range of problems.
