

Literacy

Children will complete literacy tasks linked to our topic. For example, writing a first person recount as Grace Darling about her famous night of bravery at sea.

We will also get a chance to write a persuasive piece of writing to convince people to visit the exciting seaside towns that we have created.

We will also look at more fiction stories beginning with Roald Dahl and some of his most popular stories such as *The Enormous Crocodile* and *George's Marvellous Medicine!* The children discuss the use of language, write about their favourite characters and even get a chance to create their own version!



Numeracy

Children will strengthen their calculation skills by adding two 2-digit numbers and subtracting a 2-digit number from another 2-digit number. There will be a chance to develop reasoning skills and to solve missing number problems such as $__ - 14 = 28$.

We will continue our work on multiplication and division by putting them into investigative contexts so children can apply their knowledge of the 2, 5 and 10 times table to solve problems.



Pupils will get a chance to investigate measurement in the practical context of mass and capacity. They will learn how to read scales where not all numbers are given and to compare units of measurement.
