Dear Parents/Carers

Classes 5 and 6 will be visiting the House of Objects and the Rising Sun Country Park on Thursday 13th February 2014. This trip is to give children the chance to gain first hand experience of recycling and making rubbish monsters to link with our topic this term.

We will be travelling by coach leaving school at 9.30am and returning at 3.00pm. On the day we will be taken on a tour by the wardens and then the wardens will then accompany each class for the full day. We will be involved in a recycling workshop at the House of Objects as well as an outdoor adventure activity. It should be an exciting and fun filled day!

Children will need to bring a packed lunch on the day. If your child is entitled to free school meals and you would like school to provide a packed lunch please let us know by Friday 7th February.

As the children will be outside for part of the day they will need to wear comfortable and sensible footwear, warm clothes and a waterproof coat. Children do not have to wear full school uniform but please ensure they have a school jumper/cardigan. It is advisable to put packed lunches in a small rucksack so that children can have their hands free to explore.

We are asking for a contribution of £10.50 towards the cost of the trip which includes the entry to the Rising Sun Country Park and House of Objects, all the activities and the support of a warden for each class, as well as the cost of the coach. In accordance with the 1988 Education Reform Act we can only ask for a voluntary contribution of £10.50 to cover the cost of the visit. We are aware that the price is quite substantial, but we assure you it is worth every penny. If it is not possible to fund the trip with voluntary contributions then regrettably the trip cannot take place.

If your child is eligible for free school meals there is no charge.
