The children will look at the different types of teeth and their functions. Look at the structure of a tooth. They will think about how we care for our teeth and Investigate how what we eat and drink is important for healthy teeth. They will also Investigate how teeth aid the digestive system, experimenting with different types of food. They will also look at animal skulls and teeth determine whether omnivore, herbivore, carnivore

RE

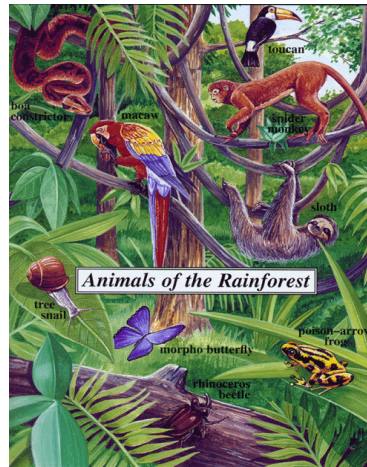
Children will explore the key beliefs and practices in Sikhism and connect some key ideas with their own experience. They will learn about the life of Guru Nanak and the symbolism of Sikh artefacts.

Art/DT

The children will look at rainforest paintings and collage pictures and use these to recreate their own versions. They will create collage animal masks and also design and make a rainforest board game.
In design technology children will make a rainforest animal with moving parts

PHSCE

Children will learn about the importance of exercise and the effect on different parts of the body. They will investigate how others spend their leisure time and will consider the effect of media and peer influence on their lifestyles, through role-play.



Rainforest

German

Children will continue to learn basic conversational German, through games, songs and practical activities.



Geography

The children will locate rainforests on world map. Use Atlas' to list countries with rainforests Investigate different layers of the rainforest - Emergent, Canopy, Understorey, Forest Floor and the plants and animals found in each. They will research some of the animals that live in the rainforest. Threatened environment – investigate which animals are at risk, disappearing rainforests. What everyday products do we get from

ICT

Children will research weather conditions in the rainforest in order to create a weather or travel report using video. They will make a trip Slide-show/PowerPoint or publisher poster to enlarge to A3 to present their research. They will also look at rainforest artwork using revelation natural art. Finally children will design a wanted poster for the enormous crocodile

Music

The children will learn how music can be used descriptively to represent different animal characteristics. They will learn and perform songs with actions, and use tuned percussion Instruments to represent different animal movements and sounds. Children will build up to developing an animal narration and will perform and evaluate as a group.
