Year 4 visit to Great North Museum

On Wednesday 7th October, Year 4 will be visiting the Great North Museum, to undertake activities linked to our Ancient Egypt topic and exploring the museum itself.

We shall be departing school at 9.00am prompt, to travel on public transport, and the children will return for the end of the school day at 3.15pm.

A packed lunch will be required. If your child is entitled to free school meals because you are in receipt of benefits or are pupil premium please contact the office to let them know if you would like school to provide one no later than Friday 2nd October. School uniform must be worn for this visit and a coat is essential.

In accordance with the 1988 Education Reform Act we can only ask for a voluntary contribution of £1.00 to cover the cost of the Metro fare, payable through ParentPay. If it is not possible to fund the trip with voluntary contributions then regrettably the trip cannot take place. If your child is entitled to free school meals because you are in receipt of benefits, or are pupil premium, then there will be no charge.

If your child is eligible for free school meals there will be no charge.

As usual, we rely on parent volunteers to take children on visits, if you are willing to accompany us on this visit please let your child's class teacher know as soon as possible.
