As part of our Roald Dahl week your child has been selected to take part in an exciting Quentin Blake 'quirky characters' workshop at the Laing Art Gallery on Thursday 27th September from 1.00-2.30pm in the afternoon. The visit will be during school hours, children should wear school uniform. As the weather is getting colder, a coat and sensible shoes will be needed for the walk to and from the metro station.

The children will be exploring the Quentin Blake: 'As Large As Life' exhibition through creative gallery games and will be creating their own wacky characters, using ink and watercolours, to show the rest of the school.
