Literacy

In narrative texts the children will cover a range of plays and scripts from other cultures. Non-fiction includes reading and writing information texts, through looking at instructions, reports, leaflets and posters. The children will also complete writing tasks linked to their work on Space. In speaking and listening, children will take part in drama, role - play and hot-seating activities. They will also have the opportunity to present their work to others, where appropriate, using ICT. Guided Reading and Comprehension sessions will take place each week; children will complete a series of activities and tasks to support with the acquisition and development of reading skills.

Numeracy

The children will add and subtract mentally pairs of two digit numbers. They will be encouraged to explain their methods orally. They should learn the multiplication facts up to 10 x 10 and be able to derive the corresponding division facts. They will be encouraged to analyse and interpret the data in tables, diagrams, tally charts, pictograms and bar charts, using ICT where appropriate. They should choose and use standard metric units and their abbreviations when estimating, measuring and recording length, weight and capacity. All children will have a weekly problem solving session, and in addition, two short sessions that focus on key skills in mathematics. Children will also use ICT to support their learning.
