Literacy

Using our theme of minibeasts the children will read and write poems based on creepy crawlies. They will be encouraged to generate rhymes and to use descriptive language for effect. Through the minibeasts topic the children will create reports about different minibeasts and write labels and captions, building on work previously taught in literacy.

We will be using our minibeast work to look at alphabetical order and definitions and also writing rules about how to care for our new little friends.

Numeracy

In maths we will continue to learn and develop new strategies for adding and subtracting including working mentally, using the number lines and number squares, and using a range of written methods.

After collecting information in tallies and lists we will create tables, pictograms and block graphs. We will ask and answer questions from these.

By the end of term we aim to know all our doubles to at least 10 + 10, our bonds to 10 and 20, be able to count on and back in twos, fives and tens as well as being able to make up amounts of money to £1.
