Literacy

She sells seashells on the seashore..., eager elephants eat eggs elegantly, there once was a man called Fred who never got out of bed... Limericks, tongue twisters, riddles, silly verses and humorous poems will be read and created by the children in literacy.

For their non-fiction work year 2 will investigate and record the key features of explanation texts. The children will learn about and work to produce a simple flowchart or cyclical diagram with time connectives to explain a process.

We will also look at playscripts and have go at writing our own!



Numeracy

Subtraction will be a strong focus this term with the children using the counting up method to answer subtraction questions. We will also continue with our work on the other three operations.

In year 2 we are brilliant at recording information in a variety of ways such as tables and charts. We will continue to practice interpreting data from a graph answering questions such as 'how many more, what is the difference...'

We will also be covering work on shape and measures.
