RESIDENTIAL VISIT(S) TO HAWKHIRST SCOUT ACTIVITY CENTRE FOR YEAR 4

Dear Parent/Carer,

This letter is to share with you the dates of our Year 4 residential visit to Hawkhirst. In anticipation of a high level of interest, the following dates have been arranged.

Wednesday 30th March to Friday 1st April 2022 - Class 9

Wednesday 6th April to Friday 8th April 2022 - Class 10

If fewer children wish to go, we will select one of the above dates.

After final confirmation of the costs for 2022 from Hawkhirst and the coach company, the total cost will be £190.00 per child which will be put on ParentPay for you to pay. This can be paid in full or by instalments. The cost covers the cost of the transport, accommodation, food, entry to the bird of prey centre, additional snacks, and the staff and activities at Hawkhirst. If you are currently in receipt of Free School Meals, the option to contribute to the cost will be available to you, however, school can support with the cost of the visit.

The first payment of a £70 non-refundable deposit (or full amount) is due by 15th October with the deadline for the final amount to be paid is Friday 11th February. If paying be instalments, it is proposed:

- £40 1st December
- £40 1st January
- £40 11th February

Nearer the visit there will be a chance for parents to meet with us and ask questions, then later another meeting for you and your child.
